Our School was affiliated to CBSE New Delhi in the year 2003.

The first batch of Xth Standard came out with flying colours and brought laurels to the institution. The results in subsequent years augmented the fame and the prestige of the school.

→The total strength of our school was 1105 from class 1 to 10 and 56 trained and well experienced dedicated teachers who strive hard to mould the students to reach out their aims and dreams.

→In 2016-17, 36 out of 59 students of Xth standard scored A1 in all subjects.

→Envisaging the overall development of the children the school has taken up a number of activities.

→On World Environment Day (5th June 2017) students participated in Tree plantation. The senior students gifted saplings to the junior students and planted in the school compound. Awareness campaign were setup by class X students in conserving wet lands and wild life. Steve Manuel Jomi and Anunadh KM of Xth standard displayed a beautiful presentation regarding environmental conservation.

→A quiz completion was held on 15th August 2017 in connection with Independence Day celebration.

→School kalotsav was conducted in the month of August. The students were grouped in to four houses and inter-house competitions were conducted as usual.

→The winners of school kalotsav were participated in the Inter school competition and the mesmerising performance of our students placed us on the winning streak and easily secured the first position for the 5th consecutive year.

→In the National Science Congress held at Silver Hills Public School Kozhikkode on November 4th, a project concerning the protection of apple snail, its extinction and its importance in paddy field, a team of 6 students participated, marking the presence of St. Meeras.

→Students of 8,9,10 were taken for a field trip on June 19th to the Seed farm Perambra. They got chance to experience paddy cultivation using modern technology.

→On Agricultural Day students of 6,7 & 8 attended a seminar and exhibition held by Indian Institute of Spices Research Centre Peruvannamoozhi.

→Students got a chance to visit CKGM Government College Perambra and enjoy their special programme - 'Sasthrayan'
